The program seeks "to empower women with knowledge of their health rights," and will focus on cancer patients' rights, particularly breast cancer patients; reproductive health and safe motherhood; adolescent sexual and psychological health; and the health of underserved women. Dr. Al-Amoudi is a renowned clinician, researcher and breast cancer advocate in the Middle East, as well as globally, with a long list of accomplishments in both innovating and advancing the regional and global cancer agenda.
