Background : KAU University Hospital was established by the late Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Fahd bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud while he was crown prince in 1976, 1396 AH. Initially the University Hospital had a capacity of 36 beds, and in the following years the number was increased gradually to 291 beds. The New King Abdul Aziz University Hospital was inaugurated by the Custodian of the two Holy Mosques -during his reign as crown prince in 1996 AH. The Hospital worked initially at a capacity of 250 beds, and increased to about 400 beds by 2002. Total capacity today is 895 beds.

Medicine Program

Course Descriptions:

FOND 101 : Foundation Course

This course deals with basic subjects to identify the requirements of basic medical sciences, and teaches students medical terminology and introduces them to the principles of medical education.

ANTM 212 : General Anatomy (1)

To identify the precise anatomical configuration of the components of human parts, the upper and lower chest, abdomen and pelvis and the perineum through practical anatomy and previous autopsy study samples and museum samples.

ANTM 211 : Cells and Tissues

Knowledge of different textile techniques to obtain tissue samples and methods of cutting and dying.

ANTM 213 : Embryology

Understanding of the stages of normal development of sperm and gamete and embryo and causes of congenital defects and variations.

BCHM 211 : Biochemical Basis of Medicine (1)

Knowledge and appreciation of the functions of the surrounding tissue cells and function of proteins to work as a pump or portal or conduit for different materials.

PATM 211 : Pathology (1)

Investigation of the benefits and applications of laboratory tests and techniques; illustrations of the various diseases, diagnostic methods, disease progression and response to treatment.

SYS 220 : Musculoskeletal System

Student study Musculoskeletal system from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 223 : Immune, Blood lymphatic System

Students study the immune system and blood from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 223 : Immune, Blood lymphatic System

Students study the immune system and blood from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

CLC 231 : Basic Emergency Care

Students study the basics of emergency care from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 327 : Urinary System

Student study the renal and urinary system from the functional, structural pathological aspects.

SYS 222 : Respiratory System

Students study the respiratory system from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

MICM 311 : Medical Microbiology (1)

The application component of this course consists of the properties of microbiology and methods of infection and disease caused by microscopic diagnosis, treatment and immunization. Study of infectious disease cases diagnosed in the various organs of the body is included in the clinical component.

PHAM 311 : Medical Pharmacology

This module provides medical students with the basics of Pharmacology, focusing on areas related to medicine.

CLC 332, CLC 333 : Title Early Clinical Experience and Communication Skills(1),(2)

Students in this module learn interpersonal communication skills within small groups, with some clinical skills.

CLC 435 : Medical Genetics

Student study medical genetics from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 328 : Title Gastrointestinal System

Students study the Gastrointestinal system from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 329 : Nervous System and Special Senses

Students study the nervous system and senses from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 325 : Endocrine System

The order and the formation and function of the organs of endocrine glands including the pituitary gland parathyroid, adrenal and their relationship to health and growth and development of cases of patients.

SYS 326 : Reproductive System

Student study the reproductive system from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

SYS 324 : Nutrition and Metabolism

Students study nutrition and metabolism from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

CLC 434 : Basic Imaging

Students study basic knowledge of different types of radiologic imaging showing the normal and comparing them to the abnormal patient status.

CLC 436 : Laboratory Medicine

Laboratory Medicine aims to involve students in the role of Laboratory Medicine in the clinical diagnosis, and teaches students how to be positive in working as a team.

PATM 413 : Forensic Medicine Professionalism

Students study Forensic Medicine and Toxicology from functional, structural and pathological aspects.

COM 431 : Community Medicine

Learning in a holistic way to deal with health problems and diseases in the community (health promotion / prevention / treatment / rehabilitation)

ENT531 : Otorhinolaryngology

Student learns how to obtain the history of diseases and acquire the skills necessary to examine the ear, nose and throat and how to perform some simple procedures.

OPH 531 : Ophthalmology

Diagnosis and treatment of sudden blindness, progressive loss of vision, eyelid disorder, tears, Red eye, refraction disorder, strabismus, neurological diseases, eye diseases and other body diseases.

Medicine Program

EL 414 : Special study module & elective(1)

Course Descriptions Students study elective hours in the curriculum in which they wish to expand their knowledge.

PEDM 531 : Pediatrics

This course investigates the various pediatric common diseases that affect the various organs of the body; diseases of the digestive system, respiratory, nervous system, diseases of the newborn, diseases of the infection, arthritis and others.

MEDM 533 : Psychiatry

Provides students with knowledge of the most important Psychiatric diseases and methods of diagnosis and treatment.

ANS 531 : Anesthesia/ICU

This course aims to enable students to obtain knowledge of ICU, and the related behavioral and psychological skills needed before, during and after surgeries as well as during periods of critical need for nursing care.

COM 632 : Family Medicine

This course focuses on building the knowledge, skills and professional behavior needed to treat the health problems that are commonly tackled by the family medicine practitioner; in addition to practice in employing the psychological approach.

EL 541 : Special study module & elective(2)

Students study elective hours in the modules in which they wish to expand their knowledge.

OBSG 531 : Obstetrics and Gynecology

This course aims to give students the opportunity to practice and provides them with the necessary information in the field of comprehensive medical care for women and girls. Students must obtain the history of the disease and focus on the aspect of gynecological and obstetric in addition to being able to conduct the general clinical examination.

MED 632 : Medicine + all sub specialties (22) + Patient Safety (2)

A selection of subspecialties in internal medicine - diagnostic methods and treatment of coronary circulatory failure - Chronic renal failure and severe - systemic lupus erythematosus - disease of the liver, acute and chronic - inflammation of the intestine - endocrine diseases - rheumatic diseases - allergic diseases - heart disorders - Osteoporosis -- arterial inflammatory disease - acid alkaline balance - Acquired immune deficiency syndrome - SARS - Avian Flu- tuberculosis and its spread outside the lungs - critical situations in allergic diseases - Toxicology and treatment - disease of blood cancer - blood transfusion - blood clotting and arterial venous.

SURG 632 : Surgery + all sub specialties (22) + Accident & Emergency (2)

Students learn surgical methods and non-surgical treatment of diseases, particularly diseases that pose a threat to the patient's life or some parts of the body.
